FOOD ALLERGIES - CLASSROOM SAFETY

Emergency Preparedness:

- ◆ Ensure immediate access to emergency epinephrine (MN Statute 121A.2205)
- ♦ Know allergic symptoms & treatment protocols (MN Statute 121A.2205)
- ◆ Treat allergic reactions promptly! (MN Statutes 121A.2205 and 604A.01)

Prevention:

- Wash hands before and after eating
- Serve safe snacks (have parents read labels)
- Eschew cross-contamination with other foods served or equipment & utensils used
- Avoid class projects with allergenic foods

Information:

- ♦ Keep IHP or 504 information & emergency plan in visible, obvious place for teachers, staff & substitutes to quickly access
- Ensure annual or twice-annual emergency training for all staff
- ◆ Evaluate accommodations annually or more often as a student's needs change
